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## City of Imlay City Road Rehabilitation Project Wins Quality of Life Award

**Flint, Michigan, February 16, 2018** – The City of Imlay City's project to rehabilitate Capac and North Fairgrounds roads was chosen by the American Public Works Association-Michigan Chapter for a Quality of Life Award.

The fall 2017 road resurfacing project included adding designated bike lanes to the streets. The award nomination indicated the lanes increase quality of life in the city by reducing emissions in the environment, making non-motorized travel along the roadway safer, and offering residents a healthy way to travel.
