

(3) TRAFFIC IMPACT STUDIES-WHAT, WHEN, AND HOW?

This session will touch on the major components of a traffic impact study, discuss when they should be required, and outline how this requiremen should be included in your ordinance. Traffic impact studies can be performed for developments of all sizes and most follow the same basic process; however, the recommendations are unique to each location. The review process and analysis procedures are much more standardized today, which also allows for better results. We will discuss the improvements in technology and analysis techniques to prepare communities for both new and redevelopment projects.



WHAT TO DO WHEN IT IS NOT IN THE BOOK?
